

RESOLUTION 2010-2

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING
A REQUEST TO CHANGE THE ACCESS CATEGORY
OF THE STATE HIGHWAY 285 FROM MILE POST 127.2 TO MILE POST 124.6,
AND, STATE HIGHWAY 50 FROM MILE POST 21.5 TO COUNTY ROAD 220
FROM RURAL ARTERIAL (R-A) TO NON-RURAL ARTERIAL (N-RA)**

WHEREAS, the present access category for State Highway 285 from mile post 127.208 to mile post 126.209, and for State Highway 50 from mile post 216.596 to mile post 220.000, is currently designated as Rural Arterial (R-A); and

WHEREAS, Section two of the Colorado State Highway Access Code (1998) requires the “appropriate local authority” to request changes in the assigned Categories of State Highway by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Poncha Springs is the appropriate local authority for Poncha Springs Colorado, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Poncha Springs, acknowledges that the existing and planned developments along both sides of State Highway from mile post 127.208 to mile post 126.209 and for State Highway 50 from mile post 216.596 to mile post 220.000, are more representative of urban development than rural development.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF PONCHA SPRINGS AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Request for Category Change. The Town of Poncha Springs Board of Trustees hereby request that the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) change the access category for State Highway 285 from mile post 127.208 to mile post 126.209, and for State Highway 50 from mile post 216.596 to mile post 220.000 from Rural Arterial (R-A) to Non-Rural Arterial (NRA). Staff is hereby authorized to submit such a request to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT).
