

PONCHA SPRINGS UPPER & LOWER CEMETERY BURIALS 1882 - 1985

Poncha Springs Town Hall, Poncha Springs, Colorado 81242 (phone-303-539-6882) and the Holman families of Poncha Springs have what few records that exist, consisting of handwritten notes and hand-drawn maps. The Poncha Springs Cemetery is located on County Road 206, about one-half mile southeast of Poncha Springs on the right side of Highway 285 on a steep hillside.

The cemetery has two separate sections, the first is called the Lower or Old section and is where all of the old burials have taken place since the townsfolk got together and moved their dead from surrounding early day cemeteries, such as Droney Pasture and Centerville, around 1882 or 1883. William H. Champ Jr. who was born and died in 1882, may have been the first burial in this cemetery since it is thought that Helen G. McPherson was the second person to be buried in the Poncha Cemetery according to Dr. Wendell Hutchinson of Salida, Colorado. She died in February of 1883.

The graves of Finley Kane and the Boon brothers, David and Samuel located in Section F were among the first to be buried when the new cemetery was started. Originally, they had been in Droney Pasture cemetery after having been killed in the outbreak of the Lake County War in 1875.

The lower or old cemetery has sections A, B, C, D, E, and F. Section F has the oldest burials in it. Many unmarked graves are in section F. No new burials are taking place in the lower cemetery unless it is known for sure that there is burial space.

The UPPER cemetery is reached by following the road up a narrow winding road to where the hill levels out and overlooks the Lower cemetery. Apparently, the first burial to take place here was Patrick D. Costello who died 14 December 1966.
